

# Western Reserve Theatre Organ Society Restoration & Maintenance Fund

Founded in 1962, the Western Reserve Theatre Organ Society (“Chapter”) is dedicated to the restoration and maintenance of theatre pipe organs within the 18 counties of the Ohio Western Reserve – centered in Cleveland, Ohio. In 1970 the Chapter saved the 3/15 Wurlitzer from the Stanley Warner Theatre in Erie, PA and installed it in historic Grays Armory in downtown Cleveland. Today this instrument is used for regular organ concerts by world class professional artists open to the general public.

In addition to ongoing maintenance of the Cleveland Grays Armory Museum Wurlitzer, the Chapter has completed the installation of a 4/28 Wurlitzer in the Performing Arts Center (“PAC”) at the Cleveland Masonic Auditorium. The PAC is a 2,000 seat auditorium with excellent acoustics and is another great venue for theatre organ concerts.

WRTOS operates its concerts on a break-even basis to make them available to the widest possible audience. As such, we depend upon donations to fund the considerable expense of restoration and ongoing maintenance of these nearly a century old instruments.

WRTOS is a tax exempt, non-profit, 501(c)(3) educational corporation in the State of Ohio.
